A motion was made by Missionary Yvonne Houston that the minutes be received and adopted as read with the necessary corrections if there be any. A Second motion was made by Deaconess Debra Jiles.

TRUSTEE REPORT

In the year 2022 we had a total in Treasury of \$203,946, \$185,886 was paid out in utilities and expense.

The Trustees are asking in the year 2023 for the church to help raise an additional \$50,000.

## ASSISTANT HELENA REID REPORT

Pastor Reid stated that in February 2023 that she want all Ministers to receive a schedule for the year to let them know what Sunday they will be serving communion in advance. She also asked that all be respectful to God's house during prayer. Pastor Reid said that the year of 2023 is to be a year of order and structure and she asked that after going through the packets if there are any questions pertaining to the information we received ask, if you need help there is someone to gladly help you.

## Deacon Clifton Jones Report

Started by explaining what the chairmen of the board does. The chairmen takes view of the ministry and the business of the church and that you must marry the money to the vision of the church.

Operations system works with the board and makes plans to operate and build the church. The fellowship hall in the lower level has been completed and he asked all to go down and see what's happening in your church. The Orange room and other projects to the lower level still must be done.

The Board reduce risk and make sure we are compliant with the government and see that important matters can be taken care of.

He let everyone know we have the money for the pointing and that permits had to be submitted to have the work done. We also will have to wait until the winter is over before work can be done.

There has been some set back, the pipes busted this year and set us back financially.

Deacon Jones also asked that you refer to the right people for correct information people do not always see what the pastor see and have to deal with but when things happen he will deal with them unbeknown to you, he will have things fixed and keep it moving.

The church now has a mobile app to be downloaded to your phone. So you can stay connected to the church. You can Tithe, send prayer requests etc. through this app.

We are going to start buying housing to help others and it will bring resources to the church, we must be progressive, we must have ideas to build funds to make things happen, you can do nothing without finance. He asked if there was any who would like to seed into the vision. One final note, we must believe in the vision that Apostle has and sees for the church.

## Apostle Vance L Dash Sr. Report

The Apostle thanked everyone for all they had done to help accomplish the vision and for staying for staying for the business meeting. He wants the people to remember that ministry is more than spirit but also there is a business side, church is more than casting out devils.

1. This year pastor stated he would like to double the LLC.

We have a group that uses the church once a month called the “Emergence Group.” This group is designed to start getting funds to purchase housing and build a real estate base. If the group has over 100 houses it can help us sustain a money flow besides Tithe and address housing for those with needs in the community.

### These are some things the Apostle also covered.

2. The hall downstairs was completed.

The H vac, the H vac system that we have originally came from the old church on Smedley Street, it is old and needs to be replaced. We have acquired quotes for a New one and we are waiting on another.

3. In 2023 Apostle would like to convert all the lighting in the church to LED lighting, it would save on the electric.
4. There is a project He would like to see done and that is clean out all the junk in the room next to the kitchen and keep it clean.
5. In regard to renovations to the Orange room down stairs, Sister Terryann had someone from the city come in and point out what needs to be done, one thing for sure it will need a new floor laid and paint, updates to this project will be forthcoming.
6. Youth room to be redone and we will need everyone’s help financially to complete this task.
7. Administration area, we would like to get a new floor and have it painted to make it a more pleasant place to work.
8. Zoe Bible Institute we would like to reestablish it and find Teachers to help teach. He wanted everyone to know that the Zoe Bible School is a credited institute since 2006.

## Various Questions from Members

Bernedette Miller- Stated that the Culinary department has forms for anyone who would like to use the kitchen or hall and she would like to implement this procedure again for all those who would like to use the kitchen. She also stated that whoever uses the kitchen or hall it is their job to also clean it after the event. It shows respect for the house of God to keep it clean.

Tyrone Lewis - commented on the work that needs to be done in and outside of the church and asked if anyone had the church surveyed to find out all of what needs to be done to do the work that is needed. Brother David Whitaker agreed with Tyrone's comment. He also added how they do things at his job how they strategize and collaborate on things to do and how they can be done and in the end they also have a total cost summary of all things needed to do the job and they all work towards the goal to complete it.

He suggested getting a licensed professional to get a concept of what needs to be done. Apostle Dash welcomed the idea of having the whole church surveyed.

Bertha Burke- suggested brother Tyrone does the survey since he is a professional.

Gena Ford- wanted to know if there is any more information regarding CPR training. Apostle stated Pastor Reid had information about CPR training that is done through the Red Cross that comes to her job. Sister Yvonne also investigated the training and found that it is a cost if the church wanted to do it.

Stephanie Lee- asked if when joining an auxiliary or ministry wherein you are qualified to work who makes the final decision as to whether you can be in that department or not. The Apostle answered he wants to trust the leader of that ministry to make the decision. A leader should be able to handle some conflicts and troubleshoot where the conflict is or they feel will be and not allow the person to function in that area. Pastor Reid added that the people must go to the person and the leader must handle the person in the right way.

### 2024 Chief Operations Report

#### 2023 Facilities/Operations/Technology/Building Accomplishments

1. New wireless heat control installed in the Sanctuary. We can control from our mobile phones. More to come in the near future.
2. Heating wire has been added to kitchen pipes, in an effort to prevent frozen pipes.
3. Remodeling the lower fellowship hall completed.
4. Pulpit spaghetti wires covered for aesthetics.

5. The masonry work/pointing on the “Crown” outside of the church was 80% completed. The remaining areas are stained glass windows masonry framing and tower.
6. Center Roof repair to prevent water intrusion on electrical panels.
7. Floors on the administration side were redone.
8. Wi-fi system was relocated to make the signal stronger and enhance Wi-Fi Capabilities.
9. Big Screen TV added to Fellowship Hall – can be used for information, virtual sessions, funerals, Sanctuary overflow, etc.
10. A new ring alarm system installed – win and fail, we continue to have some difficulties which we are addressing.
